Mr. Beverly called the meeting to order at 9:02 am. A quorum of the Committee members was present. Ms. Magwood was designated to take minutes.

Approval of Minutes

Ms. Fine moved to approve the minutes from February 6, 2023, meeting as presented. Dr. Kumar seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Governance Committee Update

Bill 8-23 - Pending Changes to Open Meetings Act

Ms. Hardy discussed the recent introduction of Bill 8-23, which provides more specificity around the time in which minutes and agendas are posted, and the impact of the proposed changes on MCEDC's current recordkeeping procedures. Ms. Hardy noted that a Government Operations and Fiscal Policy (GO) Committee work session is tentatively scheduled for March 2, 2023, to discuss the Bill.

Bill 8-23 would:

- 1. require boards, committees, and commissions to publish, within certain timeframes, the dates, times and locations of meetings, meeting agendas, and meeting minutes;
- require boards, committees, and commissions to make meeting recordings available under certain circumstances;
- 3. require the posting of draft meeting minutes under certain circumstances;
- 4. require certain reporting by the Office of the County Executive to the Council; and
- 5. generally, amend the laws regarding boards, committees, and commissions and regarding open meetings.

Draft March Board Meeting Agenda

The Committee reviewed the draft Board meeting agenda. It was noted that the Board meeting will start at 8:00 am to accommodate the full agenda. No edits or modifications were suggested.
